HAZARDOUS WEATHER...

* RAIN WILL EXPAND INTO EASTERN OKLAHOMA AND FAR NORTHWEST ARKANSAS
EARLY THIS MORNING. THE RAIN WILL TRANSITION TO FREEZING
RAIN...SLEET...AND FINALLY SNOW BEGINNING THIS MORNING AS COLD AIR
MOVES INTO THE REGION BEHIND A COLD FRONT. WINTRY PRECIPITATION
WILL PERSIST INTO WEDNESDAY EVENING BEFORE TAPERING OFF FROM
NORTHWEST TO SOUTHEAST.

* AROUND 1 TO 2 INCHES OF SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATION AND LESS THAN A
TENTH OF AN INCH OF ICE ACCUMULATION IS EXPECTED THROUGH MIDNIGHT.
LESSER AMOUNTS ARE EXPECTED NORTH OF INTERSTATE 44.

* ROADS IN THE ADVISORY AREA MAY BECOME SLICK AND HAZARDOUS...
ESPECIALLY ON BRIDGES AND OVERPASSES AND NON-TREATED SURFACES.
